Suggested Run Times

| <u>Summer</u> | <u>Fall/Spring</u> | <u>Winter</u> | Zone |
|---------------|--------------------|---------------|------------------|
| 10 mins | 6 mins | 4 mins | Front yard spray |
| 4 mins | 2 mins | 1 mins | side yard spray |
| 40 mins | 25 mins | 15 mins | MP Rotors |
| 10 mins | 6 mins | 4 mins | Backyard Spray |
| 20 mins | 15 mins | 12 mins | Backyard Rotor |
| 25 mins | 20 mins | 20 mins | Flower bed |
| 6 mins | 5 mins | 4 mins | Tree Bubbler |
| 20 mins | 15 mins | 10 mins | Foundation Drip |

Notes:

New Sod - Water twice/day every day for 2 weeks until lawn is established

New or established Sod need 0 watering during Freezing temperatures

Tree - Water every other day to keep root ball moist. DO NOT over water. This can be set up on program b.

How Many Days to Water? - Please Check with your city ordinances and/or HOA restrictions regarding water day allowance.

Shady areas like side yard need less water due to lack of evaporation from sunlight.

Drip lines need more time than spray heads

Important! - This is only a guideline. Home owner is responsible for knowing plant type and amount of water recommended.

Maintenance Checklist and Warranty for Irrigation System

The following is a list of components that may require maintenance and recommended service frequency:

| <u>Components</u> | <u>Maintenance</u> | <u>Frequency</u> |
|-------------------|--------------------|------------------|
| Y Strainer | Clean Filter | yearly |
| Double Check | Test Device | yearly |
| Complete System | Run Test Cycle | Yearly |
| RF sensor | test manual | yearly |
